John U. Bacon has written for *Time*, *The New York Times*, and *ESPN Magazine*, among others. He has authored five books on business and sports, including *Bo's Lasting Lessons*, a *New York Times* and *Wall Street Journal* business best-seller. His latest book, *Third and Long: Three Years with Rich Rodriguez and the Michigan Wolverines*, comes out this fall. Bacon has taught at Miami of Ohio, Northwestern's Medill School of Journalism, and the University of Michigan. In 2009, he was awarded Michigan's Golden Apple Award, and his course was named one of "America's Ten Hottest Classes" by *The Daily Beast*. He also delivers speeches around the world, provides commentary on Michigan Radio, detnews.com and the annarborchronicle.com, and co-hosts three shows on WTKA.com, 1050 AM.

ROTARY CLUB OF ANN ARBOR SUPPORTING YOUTH AND COMMUNITY

As a supporter of the Rotary Club of Ann Arbor Golf and Tennis Outing, you can be assured that your contribution *does* make a difference in our community. Here are three examples of the programs that we support, both with funds raised through the outing, as well as through club members' time and active involvement.

SUCCESS BY 6

A startling 46 percent of kindergarten students enter school at risk for failure, with economically disadvantaged children lagging one to two years behind in language and other skills. Washtenaw Success by 6 is an initiative of more than 50 community groups working together to ensure that preschoolers get the support they need in order to succeed once they reach school.

Since 2008, the Rotary Club of Ann Arbor has donated \$22,000 to support parent/child education and literacy programs that have:

- benefitted 2,000 children annually
- provided developmental screenings for young children
- provided free books, mailed monthly, to 1,400 children living in economically disadvantaged Washtenaw County areas
- brought dozens of Rotarians to Head Start classrooms to read to preschoolers.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Higher education is a key factor in ensuring success in life. The Rotary Club of Ann Arbor has sponsored the STRIVE program at Stone High School, an alternative school, for many years. It:

- has provided \$36,000 in scholarships since 2007
- currently offers up to 14 scholarships for seniors
- teams up prospective scholarship students with Rotarian mentors
- offers two STRIVE-at-Work programs where students explore careers by touring local businesses.

TREE PLANTING

The Rotary Club of Ann Arbor has worked closely with the city's forester to replace trees lost to the emerald ash borer. Many members of the club have become actively involved in this project, which has helped transform our city. To date, they have:

- worked in 23 area parks
- spent over \$100,000 on replacement trees
- donated more than 4,500 hours of volunteer time.

This program has made great strides in bringing the community together to address this problem, with Rotary Club members working alongside Rotaract and Interact student groups, as well as residents of local neighborhoods.



Rotary Club members have planted 1,300 trees throughout the community.
